In the consideration of digital re-presentation as a productive use of memory, Daria Zhestreyva's art installation recalls previous window displays at #33W17. Incorporating furniture and the inaccessibility of the storefront, Cali D. Kurlan curated Zhest's work to speak into a world beyond what the eye sees, turning the storefront into a glass screen (#GlassFence) as a byproduct of the projections and monitors. In lieu of <a href="www.chairsinstallation.com">www.chairsinstallation.com</a>, Zhest's response feels like e collaboration in representing a hyperspace, "enhancing what it has held as satellite objects, art works, and to control a public perception of that." Zhest describes the work as "time-based, so the ideas are related in some ways that "explode" rather to create a discrete visual event with the use of memory."

During the opening, the public is invited into the projection, into a space between the installation and an immersive environment that incorporates imagery of Daria's 2D work. A shrine to our digital selves will be featured, as well as Matcha Tea\* served along with a meditation event, (Misguided) by Lucas Justinien. As the installation is about dissolving objects in space and time, the public gains access to a more enhanced vision of microcosmic interactions that speak to a macro conditioning.
